Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

I am Fr. Rolando Yadao, born and raised in the Philippines by a Catholic family. I went to San Jose Seminary in the Philippines and completed my Theological Studies and Masters in Pastoral Ministry at Loyola School of Theology, Ateneo De Manila University, Philippines. Prior to my ordination to the priesthood, I spent two years at Our Lady of Mercy in Jersey City—one year as a pastoral associate and the second year as a deacon. After my diaconate year, Fr. Frank Fano and I were ordained together on May 28, 2011 by Most Reverend Edgar da Cunha. My first parish assignment was at St. Teresa of Avila in Summit where I served as parochial vicar from July of 2011 to January of 2012. My stay at St. Teresa of Avila Parish was cut short when the Most Reverend John J. Myers gave me a new assignment as parochial vicar at Immaculate Conception Church in Secaucus in January of 2012. Since then, I served at Immaculate Conception for 12 years and 5 months, completing 2 terms, which is the allowable limit for all parochial vicars to serve in any parish in the Archdiocese. In this regard, being due for transfer, Cardinal Joseph Tobin made the decision to assign me to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Indeed, I am honored to accept this assignment and excited to join the team of dedicated clergy and staff of OLMC whom I will have the pleasure to share the passion to serve the pastoral and spiritual needs of God’s Church in Ridgewood. I look forward to sharing my priestly ministry with you and I anticipate with joy the opportunity to create memorable stories with every family of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.

TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Job 38:8-11

Carried along on a journey from good to bad to worse to unspeakable loss, Job finally is granted what he has been asking for—a meeting with God so that God could explain to him (Job) the justice of his situation, and he challenges God to prove him guilty of some offense. God speaks only when Job has emptied himself of every complaint and resentment. God's revelatory speeches are not meant to answer Job but to enlighten and educate him in the mysteries of the universe. Among them is this excerpted text about the sea. What is important in all of these explanations is the rhetorical question God seems to be asking—if God can keep this vast and complex universe (including the sea) in order, does Job not think God has the power to care for him? Where is Job's trust? Where is his faith?

2. 2 Corinthians 5:14-17

When we are convinced that Christ's love for us has been demonstrated by his self-sacrificing death, then we should be ready to love him in return and live, not for ourselves, but for him. Christ's resurrection gives us assurance that we, too, will rise from the dead. But because we are already in Christ, we experience a new reality even here, while we live on this earth for we see everything transformed by the Spirit.

3. Mark 4:35-41

This miracle story follows a usual pattern, a description of a dire threat and the call for help, the miracle itself, and then the response. The focus of this miracle is on the identity of Jesus. By the time this Gospel was written, the image of the boat had become a popular metaphor for the Church, threatened by the storms of a violent and hostile world. Meanwhile, the disciples, and those who followed them, are fear laden. They do not understand who Jesus really is, the Messiah, the Son of God. In their weak faith, they fail to comprehend the truth. Mark is encouraging his readers to understand they need not fear; Jesus is in the boat with them. The real struggle is faith overcoming fear.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. In the storms of life, whatever they may be, unemployment, family discord, illness and death, pandemics, do you look to Jesus to quiet your fears?
2. Has there ever been a time in your life when you've uttered the words, "Teacher, do you not care that I am perishing?"
3. How can I go beyond the signs of faith and grasp who Jesus is in my daily life?
