Dear Friends,

I can't believe I'm writing this. It seems too soon! I've been here exactly three and a half years, and it feels like 17! But I mean that in the best possible way, because you've made me feel at home. From the first day, you opened your arms and your hearts to me.

I remember what I wrote in my very first bulletin article back in January 2022. I said, "thank you." I was thanking you for something you hadn't even had the opportunity to do yet. I thanked you for letting me in—for allowing me to be part of your lives through weddings, baptisms, funerals, in joys and struggles—you name it. I thanked you because I knew you'd come through.

That first weekend was so overwhelming—I had never felt so welcomed. I happen to think that spirit is Mount Carmel's strongest character: warmth and welcome.

Anyway, from that moment on, I felt a freedom. Fr. Ron allowed me to simply be myself. He always let me try new things, even if they weren't his style. He's fond of saying: *"Do what you want, but I won't have to tell you—the people will."* [Oh boy, is that true! I got some great emails to prove it!]

One thing I'm especially thankful for is Fr. Ron's support of ChristLife. He only wanted something that would help people grow in faith, and grow together. He set me free

with it. Over these three years, we've hosted hundreds of people discovering Christ's personal love for them—and discovering new friends in faith. You know this man [Fr. Ron] is CRAZY in love with you, right?!?

I've learned so much from Fr. Ron. I hope St. Gabriel's can benefit from some of that wisdom, too. And, by that way, how blessed am I? In my two parish assignments, I served with Bishop Michael Saporito and the great Msgr. Ron J. Rozniak! WOW.

I'll miss the camaraderie—the laughter with Fr. Ron and Fr. Jakov—especially now that I'll be living alone in Saddle River. [Oh, woe is me...!]

I want to thank the ChristLife team, the facilitators, the kitchen and welcome crews, for making it such a powerful experience. Mt. Carmel will be moving forward with it in some fashion.

To the Mt. Carmel staff and support staff—thank you for putting up with me!

To Erin and the Contemporary Band—thank you for helping me with ChristLife, and every creative, funky thing we've tried to do at Mt. Carmel.

And again, all of you. It's hard to imagine not seeing your faces week after week. Of course, you can always visit me, but like after Thanksgiving dinner—you gotta go back home! Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Ridgewood is where it's at! I'll always be your little brother next door. And who knows, with *We Are His Witnesses*, perhaps we will find ways to partner up. We're on the same team, after all.

Pray for me and my new friends at St. Gabriel's.

There's so much I could say [you know that already!] but just know this: you've changed my life in far more ways than you might think I've changed yours. Love you!

1. Acts of the Apostles 12:1-11

From its very beginning, Acts affirms the presence of the Spirit empowering the growth of the Church in spite of every difficulty and challenge. In today's excerpt that reality is shown in a powerful way. Herod Antipas, favored by the Emperor in such a way as to overshadow the Roman Governor takes the lead in opposing the Christian movement. Having executed James (the son of Zebedee), he arrests Peter in an exorbitant display of force. Guarded by sixteen soldiers, in double chains, every human means of escape is thwarted. But all Herod's careful steps are for nothing. After the fervent prayers of the Church, the powers of this world were powerless in the face of God and Peter is freed.

2. 2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18

Having lived his life to the full, Paul describes that fullness in three vivid images that would have been understood by his contemporaries. Libations of wine or oil were often poured out at the end of a ritual ceremony, both for the Jews and the pagans. Paul pours himself out as a willing sacrifice of praise to God. In his second image, Paul compares his death to the untethering of an animal from a yoke, thus, freed for life forever with God. In the third image, drawn from the athletic world the Greeks and Romans would have known, Paul has finished the race, not for a laurel wreath, but for the glorious crown of righteousness.

3. Matthew 16:13-19

Peter's confession of faith in Matthew is more about the church than about the identity of Jesus. In Mark it is about the realization on the part of the disciples (through Peter), for the first time, that Jesus is the Messiah. In Matthew, Peter is the specially chosen one to whom the revelation of Jesus as Messiah and **Son of God** is entrusted. There is a purpose to this entrustment—Peter will serve as the foundation, the rock, for the church. In this unique role he has the authority to interpret Jesus' teaching. Nevertheless, while Peter is the foundation, Jesus is still the builder and there is no competition between the two.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. How would you answer Jesus' question, "And who do you say I am?"
2. In what ways have you "poured out your life like a libation" for the Gospel? Do you think every Christian is called to live their faith in that way?
3. How do you believe that this special call to Peter, and his successors, serves the Church?
