SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

In my homily in that “not-so “last mass,” I quoted from a note from a parishioner who could not be there. She said “Perhaps, my perception is wrong but I see us as having grown so in remarkable ways these years.” I commented, “You could leave for me no other word, no other line that means more to me than that line. We have gown together... to make our spiritual lives a better place, a place that enriches us comforts us, challenges us and gives us hope.”

My prayer for you and me, may that always be true for all of us.

Can I add a plug, or two? For those who pledged to the Annual Appeal, fulfilling that pledge really helps the parish.

And for all you golfers out there, the 3rd Annual Fr. Ron (memorial—only kidding) Golf Outing (10/9) really helps our school—the Academy of Our Lady. And I’ll be there too (but not golfing). More information to come.

1. Jeremiah 20:7-9

At this point in this book, Jeremiah had served as God's prophet for more than twenty years (his ministry lasted a total of forty years), enduring a great deal of opposition from the royal house and the Temple leadership. In fact, as this chapter began, Jeremiah had been scourged and placed in the stocks. Jeremiah complains that God has manipulated him, used him. He seeks to escape this call that has been given him. But deep down, he knows he cannot. Zeal for God's word burns deep within him and that, despite the consequences, his own security lies in God.

2. Romans 12:1-2

Paul refers to God's generous and never-failing love as the source of all the good a Christian does. Those who give themselves to God as living sacrifices of praise and worship hear and heed His word, accept His will, and are thus transformed and renewed by His grace.

3. Matthew 16:21-27

This incident follows immediately after the confession of faith heard in last Sunday's Gospel. In sharp contrast to that Gospel's divinely inspired response of Peter about Jesus' identity, today's response shows the full force of human nature. Jesus' declarations of last week notwithstanding, Peter exhibits the weakness of human nature in not understanding what Jesus' messiahship implies. The traditional ways of power, domination, wealth, prestige and influence are shunned by the Messiah and so must be by the disciple as well. The way of the cross, leading to glorification and exaltation, is for both the Master and the disciple.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Like Jeremiah, have you ever felt frustrated in your attempts to live out your faith?
2. Paul asks us not to "conform to this age." What do you think that means? Have you ever felt pressured to "conform," by family, friends, co-workers? Did you?
3. Can you think of a decision or a commitment you have made for the sake of the Gospel that brought you hardship, suffering or rejection?

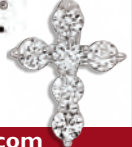
