A Christmas Message from the Pastor

Dear Friends,

In the Christmas Message, sent to all the parish households, Jesus is identified as “new Light rising in the night of the world.” There is still so much darkness in our world. The gun violence in our country, that seems to raise the specter of death or deaths every day. The precautions we face every time we board a plane, reminds us of the potential for terror that lurks just below the surface of our daily lives. There are still thousands who are homeless and jobless in the face of the general prosperity that abounds in our country. Thousands are still dying of starvation and genocide in the Southern Arabian Peninsula and northern Africa, including Nigeria, not far from Fr. Felix’s school. Death still reigns in Ukraine and in the uneasy truce in Gaza. And the never ending political divisions of our leaders and of the country as a whole. Yes, there is plenty of darkness around us.

Into this darkness comes the promise of Light. Even in the dark times of this past year, the ray of Light has shone. It shines with each visit by a Pastoral Visitor to one of our homebound, or a patient in the hospital. It shines with each casserole, prepared and delivered to the Father English Center in Paterson. It shines with each item of food or clothing dropped off at the Passaic Street entrance for young mothers in Jersey City. That light shines with the hundreds of gift cards received so children and seniors and the disadvantaged might have a brighter Christmas..It shines on the faces of the men, women and children that are helped through the tithe on our monthly giving which the parish distributes through the return to the **Sharing Our Gifts** program. It shines on the faces of every child, gathered with their families in the Religious Ed program over the last two weekends, to watch a child’s version of the Nativity story.

I am convinced that the Light shines in our parish, every minute of every day. Sometimes it’s noticeable; most times it’s not. But that Light shines because of you—and the wonderful giving of yourselves, without return, except for the knowledge that God lives and loves in you.

May I close with this year’s Christmas Message.

“A child is born to us...” (Is. 9:5)

We welcome you with joy, Almighty Lord of heaven and earth who, out of love, becomes a child.

We welcome you with gratitude, new Light rising in the night of the world.

You, Wonder-Counselor,” sure promise of peace; you, powerful presence of the “God-Hero”; you, our one God, who lie poor and humble in the dim light of the stable, welcome us around your crib.

Come, people of Mount Carmel, open to Him the doors of your history. Come to worship the Son of the Virgin Mary, who descended among us as our brother, the Prince of Peace.

Day of Joy and Peace. Celebrate it.

1. **Isaiah 7:10-14**

In this reading, the prophet confronts the pride of the royal house. King Ahaz seeks a way to secure the city against a powerful Assyria. The Northern Kingdom, Israel, has already entered into an alliance with Syria and now they seek to persuade Judah, under Ahaz' rule, to join with them. Ahaz is asked to seek a sign from the Lord but, with a dishonest humility that hides his pride, he prefers to place more trust in his own plans. Isaiah announces that the king will get the sign that he doesn't want, but instead of being a sign of deliverance, it will be a sign of his failure.

2. **Romans 1:1-7**

Paul introduces himself to a community he did not found. He writes to the Greek-speaking immigrants for whose benefit he believes he had been set apart, so that the good news of God's universal love would be made known. What will follow will be a summation of Paul's understanding of the Gospel, its message, its purpose and its consequences. But this excerpt today is the introduction in which Paul identifies himself as slave and apostle, and Jesus as Son, Who died and rose to call everyone to faith, obedience and holiness.

3. **Matthew 1:18-24**

Ever the knowledgeable Jew, Matthew uses the prophecy of Isaiah to introduce his readers to the "birth announcement" of Jesus, the Christ. Jesus is the Immanuel, the God-With-Us. Regardless of whom Isaiah might have meant, Matthew understands Jesus to be the ultimate fulfillment, the Davidic decendency fulfilled by legal adoption by Joseph, who puts aside his concern about Mary's pregnancy after the angelic appearance in his dream. In assuming the responsibility for naming the child, Joseph exercises a father's legal responsibility, assuring the fulfillment of the Isaiah prophecy.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. God promised Immanuel, God-With-Us. Do you feel God's Presence in your life? In the life of your family?
2. Because of his response, Joseph becomes the "father" (in a spiritual sense) of Jesus. How are you a spiritual parent to those around you?
3. God surprised Joseph who, nevertheless, said yes, even in his own confusion. What about you? Are you ever surprised by God? When surprised by God, do you say yes, even in your confusion?
