TODAY'S READINGS

1.Kings 19:9, 11-13

In the Old Testament, wind, earthquake and fire were regarded as media for divine communication, signaling the divine presence. Elijah goes, at God's command, to the holy mountain (Sinai or Horeb) where God spoke to Moses and where He will now speak to Elijah. But contrary to expectations, God does not speak in these usual powerful forces of nature. Instead, He speaks in a whisper choosing to be known in the quiet stillness of the human heart, made calm by its belief and serene in its hope. Thus made calm, Elijah is now prepared to accept the new assignments God has in store for him.

2.Romans 9:1-5

Healed and made whole by Jesus' love for him, Paul ached to extend the blessings he had come to know in the risen Christ to his fellow Jews, even to the extent of his willingness to be separated from Christ, if only they would accept Christ themselves. Paul reminds his Jewish brethren of all they have received from God, the covenant, the law, the

promises, the worship and, ultimately, the Son. Would that they would only accept Him as their greatest blessing.

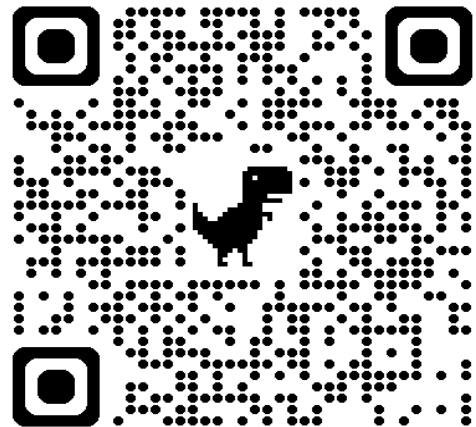
3.Matthew 14:22-33

Hidden in the middle of this passage is a simple, yet profound statement on Jesus' part. "It is I." Jesus' response to the fear of the disciples is couched in the same phrase as God is identified to Moses on Mt. Sinai. Jesus is here identified with God and does what God does, calming the raging storm and walking on the water. Jesus thus identifies Himself as God and the disciples will come to recognize this at the end of the passage. Only with eyes fixed on Christ, the Son of God, will they be kept from sinking, as Peter did.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

- 1.Has God ever spoken to you in a whisper? Do you even give Him the quiet time you need to hear and listen?
- 2.What storms threaten to engulf your boat (life)? Have you ever experienced a similar time when Jesus kept you from drowning?
- 3.Have you ever felt overwhelmed by fear? Has your faith in Jesus' love and presence given you reassurance and peace?
