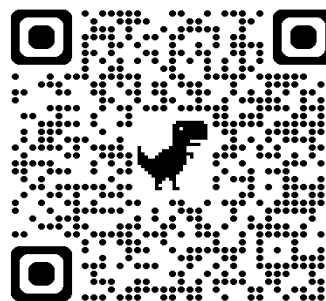
**Glory and praise to our God,
